Subj: DISMISSAL FROM THE UNITED STATES NAVAL SERVICE

1. On 20 and 21 December 1984, you were tried and convicted by general court-martial convened by Chief of Naval Air Training, Naval Air Station, Corpus Christi, Texas. Your conviction, as affirmed on appellate review, included presenting a false claim, in violation of Article 132, Uniform Code of Military Justice; and wrongfully fraternizing with an enlisted woman, not your wife, by engaging in sexual intercourse with her, in violation of Article 134, Uniform Code of Military Justice. You were sentenced to dismissal. The convening authority approved the sentence on 28 March 1985. The sentence has been affirmed on appellate review, and I have this date approved the sentence and ordered that it be executed.
2. You are hereby dismissed from the United States Naval Service.
